

Player Code of Conduct

This is a guide for players attending and participating in Wimbledon Cricket Club's training sessions, matches, tournaments, holiday camps and courses and outlines the expected minimum standards of behaviour.

Expected Minimum Standards of Behaviour Players will at all times:

Respect the rules, regulations and spirit of cricket.

Respect the rules and regulations of any venue which they are attending.

Encourage the spirit of fair play.

Encourage the dignity and worth of others.

Respect umpires, officials, coaches, players of all teams and other spectators.

Understand and appreciate that the purpose of the activities is primarily the development and enjoyment of the sport, not just competing to win.

Players will:

Be punctual to meeting times, training and for matches.

Be dressed appropriately for the activity, wearing the The Wimbledon Cricket Club kit where required.

Conduct themselves in a manner which protects their own safety and the safety of others.

Be familiar with and abide by the ECB anti-doping and equality policies.

Be aware, when participating in matches, that you are representing The Wimbledon Cricket Club and behave in a manner which preserves their reputations.

Players will never:

Participate whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Use inappropriate or abusive language, bullying or threatening behaviour.

Act in anyway which bring the sport or The Wimbledon Cricket Club into disrepute.
